Background

The Open Source Health Care Alliance (OSHCA) has successfully provided a forum for individuals interested in applying open source strategy and principles to Health Information and Communication Technologies (ICT). While OSHCA's roots are in North America and Europe, its vision is the realization of "Free/Open Source Software (FOSS) in Health Care as a viable and sustainable alternative for Health ICT worldwide". OSHCA believes that the greatest potential for positive impact on health outcomes and the greatest need lies in the developing world.

This 4-day conference will provide a meeting place for members to define OSHCA's road map for advancing the FOSS Agenda in Health, conceptualizing and defining OSHCA's role in managing FOSS collaboration, and strengthening OSHCA as a whole. The conference will also provide an opportunity to share and provide updates on FOSS applications and technologies used in health care. During the conference issues related to FOSS, open standards, interoperability and data exchange will also be discussed. The conference will also provide training sessions for new Asian programmers on FOSS concepts and health data interoperability.

The benefits and outcome of this conference will be:

- Establishing collaboration in the FOSS community for deployment of FOSS health care applications in developing countries.
- Opportunity for OSHCA to co-ordinate the interconnectivity among these systems with the goal of making them interoperable with the ability to exchange data as a specific response to the Millennium Development Goals.
- Increased knowledge in the use of open standards and data sharing technologies in FOSS health care applications and projects.
- The opportunity to establish a community network of developing countries to participate in a global collaboration for the development and improvement of open source health care applications.
- Education, training, collaboration and technology transfer on concepts and approaches to achieving interoperability between Health ICTs via open standards health ICT's to establish interoperability between open source health ICTs and existing health ICT infrastructure – R&D to test interoperability, interchange of data and standards.
- Training new developers in understanding and applying FOSS concepts, FOSS heath care applications, and health data interoperability.
- Strengthening the network with OSHCA membership and participating in defining OSHCA's evolution towards a strategic role in managing FOSS collaborative services.

This conference targets interested open source Health ICT adopters and potential adopters, from developers to end-users, including senior management both from public and private sectors.
